Certain municipalities in Washington require home security system users to obtain an alarm registration/user permit. It is your responsibility to comply with these requirements. If you fail to do so, the municipality could delay or refuse to dispatch emergency personnel and/or assess you fines.

As a courtesy, we have compiled the requirements for some areas that require an alarm registration/user permit on the reverse side of this letter. This list is not exhaustive and you should confirm registration requirements with your municipality.

Once you receive your permit (where required), please login to the subscriber portal at www.xfinity.com/xhsportal; go to the **Security** menu, select "**Emergency Dispatch Setup**" and enter your permit number along with the expiration date at the bottom of the page.

Please contact your local municipality with any questions regarding alarm registration and user permits.

I am also aware that law enforcement response may be influenced by a variety of factors including, but not limited to the availability of police units, priority of calls, weather conditions traffic conditions, emergency conditions, staffing levels, etc.

Example: If a user had a false alarm in February of 2004 and two false alarms in March of 2004, the user would be billed for any additional false alarms that occurred through December 31, 2004. The user would then "start over" for any false alarm activations occurring in the next calendar year (January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005).
